PERFORMANCE NOTES

Alleluia! He Lives! combines two classic songs, each written over 200 years apart from the other, but each containing solid Truth and relevance to today.

As you share this powerful message with your choir and congregation, remind them of the power of the resurrection of Jesus. Because of the sacrifice of Jesus, our chains of sin are broken. And as you transition into the Gaither song "Because He Lives," we are reminded that, whatever our future holds, it is in the hands of Jesus. We do not need to fear.

The design of this arrangement will work well with choir-only, or as a choir w/ praise team. The praise team parts are on separate pages at the end of this anthem. They sing along with the choir on "Alleluia! Alleluia!" (note who sings the melody) and the first statement of "Because He Lives." Then at the modulation (ms. 43) the praise team "answers" the choir phrases. This happens again at the end of the arrangement, so be sure to sing this part out.

Also, you are encouraged to have your congregation sing along with the choir/praise team, especially by the time you get to "Because He Lives."

May you proclaim with great energy that "life is worth the living, just because He lives!"
