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KRZYSZTOF PENDERECKI (Pen-der-ets-kē) was born in Debica, near Krakow, Poland on November 23, 1933 of a devoutly religious family, and his youth was deeply influenced by, and centered around, the church. In his eighteenth year, he went to school in Krakow for his higher education. At that time he began teaching himself to play the violin as a hobby. His developing interest in music led him in 1953 to study composition with Franciszek Skolyszewski and a year later to enter the State School of Music, where among his teachers were Astur Malowski and Stanislaw Wiechowicz. From Malowski, Penderecki learned to combine an adventurous musical outlook with an awareness of tradition. His graduation from the school in 1958 was marked by his composition, *Epitaph for the Death of Malowski* for timpani and strings.

Upon leaving school, he participated in the Experimental Studio of Polish Radio and Television. The *Psalms of David*, which stemmed from this period, was Penderecki's first published work. In 1959 he won first prize at the Polish Composers Association competition with *Strophes*, a work which utilizes many avant-garde techniques. Among his earlier works, Penderecki's *Threnody for the Victims of Hiroshima* first gained him international recognition.

He has continued to win many prizes and honors with a prolific output of strikingly original compositions of orchestra and chamber music, as well as choral works and an opera, *The Devils of Loudun*. His religious orientation is a prominent aspect of his works, manifest in such titles as *Dies irae*, *Utreja: Part I, The Entombment of Christ, Part II, The Resurrection of Christ* and *Stabat Mater*. The composer says: "I am a Catholic, but membership in a given church is not really the point. It's rather that I am very much concerned with . . . Auschwitz, Hiroshima . . . and the implications of the Passion . . . and I am concerned with these things in an essentially moral and social way."

Stabat Mater was composed in 1962 and later incorporated into the widely acclaimed oratorio *Passion and Death of Our Lord Jesus Christ According to St. Luke*. As part of the larger work, and as an entity, the *Stabat Mater* has been widely performed in concert and on recordings.
